

Oak Ridge High School Flea Market

Rules and Regulations For Vendors

1. Flea Market is from 7am to 1pm each week for months of March through October. Please have all materials cleared by 2pm.
2. Each spot includes four parking spaces and costs \$10. Additional spaces are charged at a rate of \$4 each. This payment funds trash removal, traffic control, flea market managers, Student Council of ORHS, and the club collecting for that week.
3. Students who collect from vendors should have an ORHS student badge and faculty member to vouch for them.
4. Vendors will purchase one temporary business license from the flea market manager per calendar month. This can be used for multiple dates only within the same calendar month. If a vendor can produce a copy of the City of Oak Ridge of Anderson County "Business (tax) License" or a certificate of registration (Sales and Use tax) from the State of Tennessee then they do not have to pay the \$5 a month tax collection.
5. Firearms and ammunition are not permitted on school property by federal and state law. They are not permitted to be presented for sale or to be in possession of flea market participants or customers.
6. Prohibited items for sale include pornographic material, drug paraphernalia, firearms or ammunition, fireworks, live animals, unsheathed swords. Vendors are asked to recall that the flea market is on the grounds of a public school system and the standards for that school system apply to all areas.
7. No animals are allowed. According to Section 6-21 of the Animal Control Ordinance Sections it is unlawful to have any animal on the grounds, property, or premises of any public school operated by the Oak Ridge School System unless the keeper of the animal has written permission from the Superintendent of Schools or his designee.
8. The use of tobacco products or smokeless tobacco devices is prohibited on school grounds at all times.
9. Non-profit groups that are not selling products need not pay the \$10, but will only be permitted two spots.
10. Vendors may not use amplifiers to sell their wares.
11. No fire pits are allowed to be used.
12. No boxes or goods should be left behind when you leave. Please clean your area and put trash in the BFI dumpster close to the Turnpike. Please do not put trash in the Chamber of Commerce's bin.
13. No metal or wooden trash containers are allowed in the BFI dumpsters.
14. Parking on the grass or sidewalks is prohibited; cars will be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense.
15. Restrooms are located at the soccer fields. Keep them clean and use trash containers provided.
16. Flea Market Managers have the authority to cancel due to inclement weather, and they are also permitted to ask a vendor to leave the market.
