Administrative Procedure 4.601.1

Reports of Withdrawal

When a student who is fifteen (15) years of age or older withdraws from school, the Superintendent of Schools and the principal shall determine whether the withdrawal is the result of circumstances beyond the student's control. Withdrawal is more than ten (10) consecutive or fifteen (15) days total unexcused absences during a single semester.

Based on this determination, Principal may notify the Department of Safety of such withdrawal. The student will then be put on notice that his/her driver's license will be suspended in thirty (30) days.
