### Tobacco-Use Prevention

Coordinated School Health will be responsible for creating and maintaining tobacco-use prevention resources for students. Instruction for the program will be created in collaboration with the local health department and local anti-drug coalition. The program will contain information and services to promote the prevention of tobacco-use as well as the cessation of all uses of tobacco, electronic/battery operated devices, vapor products, and all other associated paraphernalia.

All staff members shall be trained and provided with resources to aid in the prevention of the use of these products.

If a student violates the code of conduct due to the usage of these products, he/she may be given the opportunity to attend a tobacco cessation program before punitive measures are assessed against the student.

For more resources regarding cessation, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has created an initiative to reduce the number of youths who use tobacco.
