## Administrative Procedure 4.212.2

### Hybrid Learning

Hybrid learning can be used up to four (4) days of the required one hundred eighty (180) days of classroom instruction in the event of dangerous or extreme weather conditions, or an emergency, as determined by the Superintendent of Schools.

During hybrid learning, students in kindergarten shall have access to at least four (4) hours of instruction each day, and students in grades one through twelve (1-12) shall have access to at least six and one-half (6 ½) hours of instructions each day. Additionally, the district shall provide services required by a student's individual education plan (IEP) during this time.

Teachers shall report daily attendance to the principal for the days that hybrid learning is utilized. For students who are absent, Board Policy 6.200 shall be referenced to determine if the absence is excused or unexcused as well as whether any interventions are needed to address student absences.
