Student Psychology Services

November 15, 2024

The Student Success Coordinator shall be responsible for developing a program for making psychological services available to all students. This program shall cooperate with other entities in the community in consultative screening and assessment services.

School counselors will aid the school in providing psychological services to students as needed. A school counselor shall respect the right of privacy of the students he/she counsels. Confidentiality shall be maintained by the counselor except:

1. Where there is a clear and present danger to the student or other persons;
2. When it is in the best interest of the student to consult with a psychologist;
3. When the student and/or parent/guardian waives this privilege in writing; or
4. When subpoenaed to participate in a judicial proceeding.

If a school counselor is in doubt as to whether an exception exists, he/she shall consult with their principal and/or district leadership.
